Mary Shelley conceived the idea for *Frankenstein* during a summer vacation in 1816. The journey also included her husband, Percy Shelley, Lord Byron and John Polidori. The bad weather kept them at home and, in order to pass some time on a stormy night, Lord Byron challenged each person to write a ghost story. Mary Shelley, who was just nineteen at the time, came up with a rough draft of the story. The novel was eventually published in 1818, when she was twenty-one.
