FERULA, THE WITCH



SCENE 1.

(Enter Gretel.)

GRETEL: (She acts as if she's riding a motorcycle.) Broom!! Broom!!! Wow, there are so many people here! Who are you? Do you like my motorcycle? It's the fastest motorcycle ever! Yes, of course it's a real one. Can't you see it? Are you guys blind? Hey friends, have you seen my brother Hansel? He is not as fast as me. Could you please help me call him? Ok, let's do it, one, two, six... Oh yes! That's wrong! I'm a bit crazy. One, two, three. Hansel! Hansel!

(Enter Hansel.)

HANSEL:	Wow! There are so many people here. Who are you? Are you dwarves? You look so
	small! Oh, I know! You're kids. Hey! Have you seen my sister Gretel? She's so crazy.
	She thinks she has a motorcycle. Do you know where she is? On my right? (Gretel
	hides.) On my left? Oh! I know where she is. She's over here. Got you Gretel!
GRETEL:	You got me because you cheated!
HANSEL:	I wasn't cheating!
GRETEL:	Yes, you were!
HANSEL:	No, I wasn't!
GRETEL:	Yes!
HANSEL:	No!
GRETEL:	Let's play again! I hide!
HANSEL:	Yes! But it's getting dark! How do we get back home?
GRETEL:	I think it's this way! (To the audience.) Do you guys agree?
HANSEL:	I am not sure
GRETEL:	I think the right way is on the left.
HANSEL:	Right.
GRETEL:	Left.
HANSEL:	Right.
GRETEL:	Left.
HANSEL:	Right. (Very angry.)
GRETEL:	Left. (Very angry.)
HANSEL:	Rock-paper-scissors.



GRETEL: One, two, seven...

(Hansel laughs.)

HANSEL: Oh, sorry. It was three.

(They play rock-paper-scissors.)

GRETEL:	l won!
HANSEL:	You did.
GRETEL:	I always win!
HANSEL:	But
GRETEL:	So, let's take the path on the right, as I said

(They follow the path on the right but they get lost.)

GRETEL:	This is not the way back home.
HANSEL:	Daddy must be worried.
GRETEL:	It is getting dark. And cold. (Hansel cries.)

(A voice is heard.)

DADDY: Hansel! Gretel!

(They suddenly stop crying.)

HANSEL:	Daddy!
DADDY:	Where are you?
GRETEL:	We're over here Daddy.
DADDY:	I can't see you.
GRETEL:	(To the audience.) Friends, can you help us? Let's call out to Daddy! One, two, six
HANSEL:	Three!
GRETEL:	Yes! One, two, three!!! Daddy!!

(Daddy appears.)



DADDY:	Oh, my beloved children! Please don't do this again!
HANSEL:	It was Gretel's fault.
GRETEL:	What? Liar!
DADDY:	Your mother must be so worried too. It's getting darker and darker and I don't remember
	the way back to our house.
GRETEL:	What are we going to do Daddy?
DADDY:	Don't worry kids. I dropped little stones to mark the way back. We just need to follow
	them back and soon we will be safe at home.
HANSEL:	Yeah, lets' follow them. Dad! There's a stone here!
GRETEL:	Look! There's another one there. Yes!

(They follow the stones singing a song.)



GRETEL: Oh! We're finally home. I'm so tired. Let's go to sleep.



HANSEL: Good night, Gretel.

SCENE 2. LOST IN THE WOODS

(The kids are in the woods again.)

DADDY:	Good morning kids! I have to go to work.
GRETEL:	Ok Daddy. (To the kids.) My daddy is the best woodcutter in the area.
DADDY:	I need some help. Please clean up the house while I am away, ok?

(Hansel & Gretel don't like the idea.)

GRETEL:	Ok Daddy.
HANSEL:	Don't you worry Daddy!
DADDY:	Please kids don't be naughty. Don't go out into the woods again.
GRETEL:	No Daddy. We won't.
DADDY:	You promise?
HANSEL:	We promise Daddy.
DADDY:	People say there's a very dangerous witch in the woods.
HANSEL:	Really?
DADDY:	Yes, so behave yourselves!

(She leaves.)

HANSEL:	So Let's clean the house.
GRETEL:	No!
HANSEL:	What can we do then?
GRETEL:	Let's go out to play in the woods.
HANSEL:	But
GRETEL:	What?
HANSEL:	We might get lost, like last night.
GRETEL:	We could drop some stones to mark the way back, as Daddy did.
HANSEL:	There are no stones at home.
GRETEL:	What can we use instead of stones? Let's search!



(They try to find things to drop to mark the way back home.)

HANSEL:	Apples? There's only two!
GRETEL:	Toothbrushes? We only have three.
HANSEL:	Chairs?
HANSEL:	Brooms?
GRETEL:	Hey. What is this?
HANSEL:	What is what?
GRETEL:	There's some bread! We can use it!

(The witch is observing the scene.)

GRETEL: Yes, we can drop bread crumbs. That way, it will be easy to find the way back. **HANSEL & GRETEL:** Yes!

(The kids leave the scene dropping bread crumbs and walking into the woods.)

WITCH: Iahahaha!!! Two kids in the woods! Iahahaha!! They're going to be mine!! I need kids to clean my house and cook my food! I am so lazy! Iahahaha! They're going to be my prisoners! Iahahaha! I'll cast a spell to make the birds eat the bread crumbs. Do you want to hear the spell kids? It is called Shallakabulakabu! That's the song of the spell!

- **GRETEL:** Wow! Friends! I had the time of my life in the forest. I'm so happy!
- HANSEL: Oh! I'm so happy too! But I'm starting to get a bit cold. We need to go back home. Daddy will come back soon. Let's follow the bread crumbs.

(The song of birds.)

GRETEL:Oh no! The birds are eating our crumbs!HANSEL:Yes, they are! Oh no! How can we can return to our home?

(The kids seem very worried.)

- **GRETEL:** This is your fault.
- HANSEL: What? No! It's your fault!
- **GRETEL:** Let's go to the right.

(They start to get angry with each other.)

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- HANSEL: Ok! I'll win!
- **GRETEL:** One, two, eight...
- HANSEL: Threeeeeee!!!



GRETEL:	Ok! One, two, three! You win!
HANSEL:	Let's follow this path!

(The kids go to the left.)

GRETEL:	Hey there's a nice smell around here!
HANSEL:	Yes! It smells like chocolate! Yummy!

(The kids reach a house made of chocolate.)

GRETEL:	Wow! It looks delicious!
HANSEL:	It's made of chocolate and candy!
GRETEL:	This is the house of my dreams.
HANSEL:	Oh! I am soooo hungry!
GRETEL:	Yeah! Me too!
HANSEL:	Can we eat just a little bit?
GRETEL:	Of course, we can.
HANSEL:	But this is not ours
GRETEL:	Nobody has to know
HANSEL:	But
GRETEL:	Just a little bit
HANSEL:	Let's ask our friends.
GRETEL:	Guys! Do you think it is a good idea to eat some candy?
HANSEL:	Let's do it!

(They start eating. The witch is near the house.)

HANSEL:	What is that noise?
W ITCH:	Hello my dears! How are you?
GRETEL:	Oh madam! Who are you?
WITCH:	I am a very good woman who lives in these parts.
HANSEL:	We live nearby too, but we are lost and we're so hungry.
WITCH:	Oh! Poor little kids. Would you like something to eat?

(The witch tries to push them into the house.)



HANSEL:	Hey! That hurts!
GRETEL:	Don't push my brother!
HANSEL:	Daddy always says we mustn't talk to strangers.
W ITCH:	But I am not a stranger. I am an old lady who lives on her own in the middle of nowhere
	and tries to help lost children.

(She grabs two big lollypops from the house. The kids look hypnotised.)

WITCH: Do you want a tasty lollypop?

(They take the lollypops.)

W ITCH:	I can give you some chocolate as well, but you need to come into the house. Do you	
	want a hot chocolate?	
HANSEL:	Yes please. It's getting cold.	
WITCH:	Do you know I cook the best soup ever? I can give you soup as well.	
HANSEL:	I love soup. It would be perfect with this cold.	
GRETEL:	What should we do? We need to go back home but I'm so hungry.	
HANSEL:	What can we do now? Daddy says we shouldn't talk to strangers. They might be bad.	
GRETEL:	I want to go in!	
HANSEL:	l don't.	
GRETEL:	Rock-Paper- Scissors.	
HANSEL:	Ok!	

(They play and Hansel loses.)

W ITCH:	What are you children doing?
GRETEL:	Nothing madam, we accept your invitation.
W ITCH:	Oh! That's wonderful. Come in my dears.
GRETEL:	Ok! We'll stay here tonight and we'll try to find the way tomorrow morning.
W ITCH:	Yes! Sure, my dearest. Come into my house. I have two fluffy beds for you.

(The kids enter the house.)

HANSEL: Thank you madam. It's very kind of you.



SCENE 4. WITCH'S HOUSE

(The kids are in the house.)

GRETEL:	Oh, this house is a mess.
HANSEL:	Oh Gretel. Is this a spider web? Everything is so, so dirty.

(The witch is laughing with a spooky laugh.)

GRETEL:	Oh gosh! This is so spooky.
W ITCH:	lahahaha!! Now you kids are my prisoners. You can't escape.
HANSEL:	But our dad is waiting for us.
W ITCH:	You ate a part of my house. So, you have to pay me for it.
GRETEL:	But we don't have any money. We are poor kids.
W ITCH:	Then you'll have to work for me.
GRETEL:	Why just me?
Witch:	And I'll eat your brother.
GRETEL:	No, we will fight you!
W ITCH:	lahahaha! You fools!
GRETEL:	Come on Hansel! Let's escape!
W ITCH:	Shallakabulakabu!

(The kids are frightened.)

HANSEL:	Oh! I can't move!
W ITCH:	You can't escape!
GRETEL:	Ok! We surrender!
W ITCH:	lahahahaha! Now you kids are mine. Come on, Gretel! Clean up my house.
GRETEL:	That's so sexist!
W ITCH:	And give some food to your brother. He's too skinny. I'll eat him when he gets fatter.

GRETEL:	Yes!
HANSEL:	But we're not evil Gretel.
GRETEL:	So?
HANSEL:	We just need to wait till she's asleep.
GRETEL:	Then we'll take her key and run away.
HANSEL:	Do witches sleep?
GRETEL:	I hope so. Let me try something.
HANSEL:	Mrs Witch!



WITCH:	Don't call me like that. My name is Ferula!
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GRETEL: Ok, Mrs Ferula. We are so tired. We cleaned for you, we cooked for you and we worked hard for you. Can we rest a little bit now?

(The witch hesitates.)

GRETEL:	Sure! (She sings.)
