SCENE 1. THE THREE LITTLE PIGS

(Enter Tam and Tim.)

TAM: Wow!! Who are they, Tim? They look like friends...

TIM: Yes, they are! But they seem to be very scared of us! Are you guys scared?

TAM: No, they're not.

TIM: Yes, they are.

TAM: No, they're not.

TIM: Yes, look at this. Booh! *(She tries to scare the audience.)*

TAM: They're laughing! Aren't you, guys?

TIM: No, they are scared to death.

TAM: Try it again!

TIM: Ok! Lights down please. Don't move!

TAM: Come on, Tim... One, two... three!

TIM: Booh!

TAM: Nothing! They're not even a little bit scared.

TIM: Oh! Look! Tom is coming! Over there!

TAM: Guys! Do you think it is a good idea to scare him?

TIM: Will you help us?

TAM: Ok! We have to rehearse a little bit. Let's hide. Everyone, hide! At the count of three we all say: "Booooooh!" Are you ready?

TIM: Everyone, hide! One, two, three.... Booh!

TAM: That was amazing guys. Okay. There he comes. Silence and hide!

(Enter Tom.)

TOM: Oh! There's no one over here! Tam! Tim! Where are you? It's getting dark, and I am so worried about you guys! Tim! Tam!

(Tam makes gestures counting to three.)

TIM: One, Two, three... Booh!

TAM: Hahahaha! Wow guys, that was so good!

TOM: Tim! Tam! Oh, I'm scared to death!

(He seems to be very angry but then he finally laughs.)

TOM: Oh! My little siblings! You are so nasty but I love you both very much! *(To the audience.)*
Who are they?

TAM: They are our friends.

TOM: But do they know who we are?

TIM: I guess so...

TAM: Hey, friends! Do you know who we are?

TIM: Yes, we are the very famous three little pigs!

TAM: But we have our own names. Do you want to hear what they are?

TIM: My name is Timothy but everyone calls me Tim.

TAM: My name is Tamara but everyone calls me Tam.

TOM: My name is Thomas but everyone calls me Tom.

TIM: Tim.

TAM: Tam.

TOM: Tom.

TAM: And we are the very famous three little pigs: ¡Tom, Tam, Tim *(Song.)*

SCENE 2. THE BIG BAD WOLF

(The three little pigs are in the woods again.)

TOM: Okay guys... You must know...
TAM: What?
TOM: Winter is coming!
TIM: Oh Tom! What are we going to do?
TAM: Winter is very cold!

TIM: Yes, we need a house.
TAM: But we don't have a house!
TIM: And winter is coming!
TOM: So, we have to build a house!
TAM: What?
TIM: I'm not a builder!
TAM: Me neither. I want to be.... a singer! *(She sings.)*
TIM: And I'd like to be.... an actor!
TAM: Yes!
TOM: Guys! We need a house. Winter is very cold and we need to have somewhere to stay.
TAM: Mmmm...
TOM: And... There's a big bad wolf in this wood. We need to be safe.
TIM: A wolf?
TOM: Yes, a big one. A bad one.
TAM: I don't want to end up in a barbecue.
TIM: Neither do I!
TOM: That's why we need a new house for the winter!
TAM: Okay! You convinced me.
TOM: Let's go this way. There's a wonderful green meadow over there.

(Exit Tim and Tom.)

TAM: Guys! There is something. I didn't tell you. It is my birthday today! I am 8 years old. I am the youngest of the three little pigs. Tom is the eldest, and the second one is Tim, then me. What? Do you guys want to sing me happy birthday? Of course. You can do that.

(They start singing happy birthday as the Big bad wolf enters.)

TAM: What's the matter, friends? Oh, I can't understand a word you are saying.

(The wolf hides.)

TAM: What were we doing? Oh yes! We were singing happy birthday!

(Tim returns.)

TIM: Tam, we are waiting for you! Oh, I see. They are singing happy birthday to you. I'll join.
Happy Birthday to you...

(The wolf appears again. He tries to attack them but they move, and the wolf falls down and disappears. He tries again but he falls down again.)

TAM: Oh! Thanks a lot everyone! Thanks for singing me happy birthday.

(The wolf is watching.)

TIM: Come on Tam. Tom is waiting for us. And you know...Tom, Tam, Tim, three little pigs,
we are a Team!

TAM: Yes! Let's build our house.

(Exit the pigs.)

THE BIG BAD WOLF: *(Making gestures, imitating the pigs.)* We are a team! Tim, Tam, Tom... They have such ridiculous names. You know what? I have a very good lung. Ha, ha! Little piggies, listen to me! Your houses are no match for me, you'll see. I'll huff and I'll puff and I'll blow them all down! One, two, three - watch them hit the ground!

(They start to argue.)

TOM: You're so lazy!

TIM: Guys! What is going on?

TOM: Tam wants to build our house out of straw!

TIM: What? It wouldn't be safe!

TOM: I told you...

TIM: I want to use... Sticks!

(Tam and Tom laughs.)

TOM: Sticks are fine, but bricks will protect us from any danger.

TIM: They are so heavy!

(They start arguing again.)

TAM: Straw is a good idea!

TIM: Sticks!

TOM: Bricks!

(They keep arguing.)

TAM: Straw!

TIM: Sticks!

TOM: Bricks!

TAM: Hey! Why don't we each build our own house?

TOM: What? That's so selfish! We're a team, remember?

TIM: Tam, Tom, Tim!

TOM: Remember that straw is very weak.

TAM: I don't want to work too much.

TIM: Yeah! Me neither. Maybe Tam is right. We can each build our own house.

TOM: Okay! If that's what you want!

TAM: Don't be angry!

TOM: No worries. I hope we won't regret it.

(They start building their houses. As they build, they sing a song.)

SCENE 4. THE WOLF ATTACKS

(The pigs are in their houses when the wolf appears.)

THE BIG BAD WOLF: Hi Guys! Now it's lunch time. Have you seen any of the piggies? No? you're lying. I know they're living in these houses. Oh, this house is a mess, built out of straw.

TAM: Oh no! It's the big bad wolf! There's no one home!

(Tam hides.)

THE BIG BAD WOLF: Do you think I am stupid? Come out of the house.

TAM: I won't!

THE BIG BAD WOLF: Yes, you will...

TAM: I won't!

THE BIG BAD WOLF: "I'm much stronger than straw!"

TAM: Ye! My house is nice and heavy.

THE BIG BAD WOLF: Hahahaha! You're so stupid! Don't you guys remember my song?

I'm gonna huff, puff and blow it all away

(Huff, puff blow.)

I'm gonna huff, puff and blow it all away

(The wolf blows and knocks down the wooden house.)

TAM: Oh No! Tim! Your beautiful house!

TIM: Nooo! What are we going to do now?

THE BIG BAD WOLF: Now... *(To the audience.)* My wonderful audience. It's lunch time.

TIM: Aaaah!

TAM: Run! Tim! Run!

THE BIG BAD WOLF: You're too fat! You can't run as fast as me!

(The wolf tries to catch them but they find safety in Tom's house.)

TAM: Oh, please Tom! Open the door! The wolf is going to catch us!

TOM: Okay!

TIM: Thank you, brother!

TAM: Now I'm sure he can't knock down this house!

TIM: Silly wolf! Silly Wolf!!

THE BIG BAD WOLF: That's enough! Now I'm really angry! And I am really hungry too. I'll use the power of my lungs again. Remember the song guys?

(He leaves.)

TAM: Hurray! We beat the wolf!

TIM: You helped us a lot, thank you, friends!!
